PUBLIC INVITATION

For awarding contract on public purchasing of two systems for monitoring meteorological conditions at ski resorts "Stara planina" and Zlatibor and system for central monitoring for needs of PE "Ski Resorts of Serbia" and Republic Hydro-meteorological Institute, number of purchasing 58/08

Public Enterprise "Ski Resorts of Serbia", Bulevar umetnosti 16a, New Belgrade invites all interested bidders to submit their written offers in accordance with the conditions from the public invitation and the bidding documents.

Subject of the public invitation is public purchasing of two new systems for monitoring meteorological conditions at the ski resorts "Stara planina" and "Zlatibor" and the system for central monitoring of these for the needs of the Public Enterprise "Ski Resorts of Serbia" and the Republic Hydro-meteorological Institute, with related services and works.

The system of automatic monitoring of meteorological conditions at the ski resorts of Stara planina and Zlatibor, situated at 1,723 m and 1,497 m above sea level, serves for obtaining information on the following meteorological items: temperature, dew temperature, air humidity, air pressure, wind direction and speed, precipitation quantity, sunshine duration and height of snow covering.

Detailed technical specification of the subject of public purchasing is within the bidding documents, and the subject of public purchasing consists of the following:

- 1) Service of designing the system for automatic monitoring of meteorological conditions;
- 2) Delivery of equipment and installing and mounting the system;
- 3) Related works.

All interested domestic and foreign legal and physical entities that fulfill compulsory conditions according to the Article 45 of the Law on Public Purchasing have the right to participate in the procedure of public purchasing, and they prove fulfillment of conditions with documents from the Article 46 of the Law on Public Purchasing. Bidder is obliged to submit with his offer and evidence from the Article 46 of the Law on Public Purchasing all other documents and forms comprised in the bidding documents.

Bidders interested in participating in the procedure of public purchasing may inspect and personally take over the bidding documents at the address of the Orderer: Bulevar umetnosti 16a, 1st floor, New Belgrade, on working days

between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. When taking over the bidding documents the bidders are obliged to submit: 1. authorization for taking over the bidding documents on a document with the letterhead of a bidder (with data regarding the address, telephone, e-mail and TIN), as well as an evidence on payment of 100.00 € for redemption of the bidding documents.

Home bidders should pay amount of 100.00 € in counter value in dinars according to the mean exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia at the day of payment, at the account number 205-124079-40 with Komercijalna banka a.d., purpose of payment “Public Purchasing of system for automatic monitoring of meteorological conditions, number of purchasing 58/08”.

Foreign bidders should pay the amount of 100.00 € to the foreign currency account of PE “Ski Resorts of Serbia” with Komercijalna banka a.d. according to the following instructions:

Paid amount is not refundable and all expenses and commissions for transfer are to be borne by the bidder.

The term for submitting offers is 30 days from announcing the public invitation in the “Official Gazette of RS” until 12 a.m., i.e. until the date and time and in the manner as stated in the Bidding documents. Offers are submitted to the address:

In case that the last day of the term is not a working day, then the first next working day will be considered the last day of the term.

An offer from a bidder that has not reached the Orderer until the referred day and hour will be considered as late and such an offer will be returned to the bidder unopened after finishing of the procedure of opening offers.

Offers may be submitted in person or by registered mail.

Offers must be marked “Offer for public purchasing of system for automatic monitoring of meteorological conditions at Ski resorts”, number of purchasing 58/08 – do not open”, and on the backside of the envelope, there must be the name and address of the bidder.

The offer must be valid at least 60 days from the day of opening the offers.

Public opening of offers will be performed immediately after termination of the term for submitting offers, i.e. on the last day of the term at 12:30 a.m. in the premises of the PE “Ski Resorts of Serbia” at the address Bulevar umetnosti 16a, 1st floor, New Belgrade.

Authorized representatives of the bidders may be present at opening of offers, who will submit their written authorizations, verified with seal and signature of the authorized person, for participating in the procedure of opening of offers to the Committee for public purchasing before the beginning of opening offers.

Selection among submitted offers will be performed according to the Article 55 of the Law on Public Purchasing, according to the criterion of the economically most favorable offer. Evaluation of elements within the given criterion is explained in detail within the bidding documents.

Decision on awarding the contract will be made approximately within 15 days from the day of opening the offers. All the bidders will be informed in written form on the decision.
